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Summary

- Surprising growth in developing countries shifts the dynamics of the stabilization problem
- Recession has an impact but does not change fundamental realities of the stabilization challenge
 - It does not delay need for an immediate and sustained commitment to RD&D
- With delayed participation by developing countries, achieving stabilization at:
 - 650 CO₂-e is reasonably possible
 - 550 CO₂-e is extremely difficult
 - 450 CO₂-e is in the rearview mirror
- A commitment on the part of the Developing Countries **NOW** to reduce emissions at some date in the **FUTURE** can be a win-win proposition
